### Overseas Internship Sharing Video – Content & Production Guidelines

# (Quick Cuts + Flashy Transitions)

Use stock footage or your own clips for a cinematic start.

#### Suggested Shots (3-5 sec each):

- Airplane takeoff
- Luggage moving along an airport belt
- © Close-up shot of your eyes opening (symbolic of discovery)

🖀 We'll handle this segment. No need to shoot unless you have high-quality footage to contribute.

### MAIN VIDEO CONTENT: INTERN'S FOOTAGE (B-roll & Interview)

#### **Ⅲ** B-ROLL FOOTAGE TO CAPTURE

Please shoot horizontal (landscape) format at highest quality possible.

- Daily commute to your internship site (walking, train, bus, bike, etc.)
- Interesting places around your city (landmarks, scenery, cultural spots)
- Food scenes meals you've tried, local specialties, or market visits
- Gffice/work environment (if permitted)

Preferred Equipment: DSLR/Mirrorless, GoPro, or any camera with HD quality or etc.

Do inform us the equipment you have so that we can plan the shot accordingly. You can record as many as you can.

### SCREEN INTERVIEW (Primary Message Delivery)

Record yourself speaking directly to the camera, either seated or standing in a quiet, well-lit environment. Suggested backdrop: a nice city view, your internship site, or a clean indoor space.

### Interview Prompts (Answer clearly, 1-2 mins total):

- 1. Brief intro with name, program. Where are you interning? (Company/University & Country)
- 2. Why did you choose this company or University for your internship?
- 3. How has this experience benefited you? (You can touch on...)
  - Resume/Career advantage
  - Global networking
  - Confidence building

- Cultural immersion and unforgettable memories
- 4. Would you recommend overseas internships to other students? Why?
- 5. Any advice for students planning to intern abroad?
- Pro Tip: Write a few notes before recording, but speak naturally. Be yourself!
